Thursday 25th July

This session will give an overview of what cystinosis is and some of the clinical and research history of the condition.

This session will provide an update on the research currently being performed internationally in cystinosis. Updates will include CF 10 prodrug; everolimus; contact lens cysteamine therapy delivery; mRNA therapies; and treatment centres in the UK though the NHS system. Following the updates there will be time for discussions and questions for the speakers.

Up and coming researchers in the field of cystinosis will be displaying posters explaining their work throughout the conference. Selected speakers will have an opportunity to present and explain their work to our families with families having the opportunity to vote on the best presentation.

This is a private event for our adults with cystinosis and their partners to gather for a social outing.

09:00 Better Treatments continued

This session will be an opportunity to learn more about gene therapy, a new technology which has become noteworthy in our community. Following an introduction from Prof Paul Grimm on what stem cell and gene therapies are, Jordan Janz, the first patient to

take part in the University College San Diego study under Dr Stephanie Cherqui, will discuss his experience of the clinical trial and what it has meant for him.

Parallel break out sessions will allow people with particular interest in specific aspects of life with cystinosis to gather and discuss their thoughts and experiences in a facilitated group.

13:00 Better Health

This session will discuss living with cystinosis and the wider health implications including exercise, eye care and fertility, with an update from the IMPACT exercise study from Dr Katharina Hohenfellner.

This patient panel will be an exciting and informative session for all. A panel of adults with cystinosis will introduce themselves and share how living with cystinosis is part, but not all, of their lives.

As families join the conference and community we are aware that events like meeting here in Manchester will present a lot of information about the disease itself, treatments and research. The "Living Better" panel aims to give a reflection of what real life is like for an adult with cystinosis – how it is a part but not all of who they are and that it is possible to build normal and great lives while having to take therapies, live with the effects of cystinosis and get on with day to day living.
